# NOTES FROM NE ZONE DIRECTOR

Hello from your reappointed Northeast Zone Director!

The International Meet recently held in South Bend, Indiana was a tremendous success. The new Meet format of Wednesday through Saturday was introduced. Electronic judging for all divisions was accomplished. Elections were held and SDC business was completed. The Studebaker Drivers Club (SDC) officers now include Tom Curtis, President; Don Jones, Vice President; Jane Stinson, Treasurer; and Cindy Foust, Secretary. As far as our Zone is concerned, we now have a new Northeast Zone Coordinator. Steve Grant, from the Kinzua Chapter has been appointed. Steve is a vendor at most meets and is known as the Madd Doodler with an annual publication of a Studebaker calendar. Steve takes over from John Henne. I ran unopposed as Northeast Zone Director so I am with you for another two year term.

Our Zone Meet is coming up in June (23rd - 25th) in Sturbridge, Mass. If possible, have your Chapter take advantage of sponsoring a trophy for the event. Details of the event are publicized in the current edition of Turning Wheels. I plan on being there with my GT Hawk so stop over and say "Hi"!

The top five are rounded out with #4 1950 Champion and #5 1960 Lark. The intent of the "Authenticity Guide" is to document the correct configurations of GT Hawks as they came from the factory. A level of difficulty will be added to this project when you consider all the running changes that would have taken place during a model year run. If you have an original GT Hawk or an accurately restored one, I would love to hear from you.


