JULY MEETING RECAP



Our meeting opened at 7:58 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

JUNE MEETING RECAP:

Treasurer Frank Sammon read the May meeting recap for Roger Price, who was away. This was accepted by Bob Andreocci, and seconded by Lanning Baron.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Our treasurer, Frank Sammon, reviewed all checking account expenses and income since our last meeting.

Checking expenses included the newsletter, car show expenses including soda/water, coffee, and a registration refund. Frank noted that there are still some outstanding car show expenses. Lanning Baron asked whether he should request a return of the security check or let it ride until next year. Frank noted that the bookkeeping is cleaner if the check is returned, so Lanning will request a return of the security deposit.

Checking income included car show sponsors, membership dues, car show registrations, refreshments, 50/50, and bank interest. The only activity in our **savings account** was interest. For further information, please contact Frank.

As part of his report, Frank also mentioned that two new members have joined the group: Frank McManus, who was a member many years ago, and Jon Rand, who was signed up as a member by Victor Clausen.

The Treasurer's Report was accepted by Tom Portesy, and seconded by Lanning Baron.

REUNION SUNDAY:

A discussion was held regarding the car show date, since we were bumped from our usual June date. The concern was that the same may happen

next year. Since the attendance was lower than normal with the Father's Day show date, it was decided not to have that for the show date next year. Lanning Baron suggested looking for a May date instead if we cannot get the date we normally have. He suggested the weekend after Mother's Day. Those in attendance agreed that only some days in May will work, as both Mother's Day and Memorial Day weekend need to be avoided.

The result of the discussion was that we will look into other date possibilities.

Kevin will send out "Thank You" notes to the Sponsors and trophies to those who won but left the show before the awards were presented. Kevin also suggested sending trophies to those sponsors who sponsored a class that had no entrants. The group agreed that this was a great idea.

WARWICK, R.I.:

Tom explained that International meets generally draw cars from a 300-500 mile radius; when the show is on a coast, part of that radius is missing, so the draw area is smaller.

Tom also noted that there was a fee for shoppers to get into the indoor swap meet, and it was \$55.00 the day of the show (\$45, plus a late fee if not done at registration). Vendors could get in due to their vendor registration. Tom thought that this aspect would be a subject of much further discussion.

Next year's International Meet will be in South Bend.

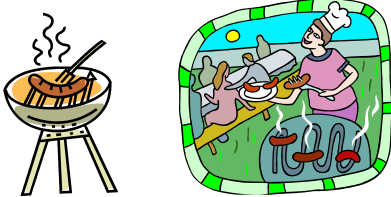

CHAPTER BARBECUE

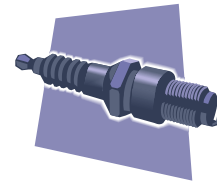

TECH TIPS



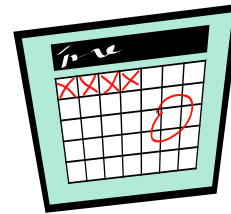
Spark Plug Wires

Something that is overlooked in the maintenance of your Studebaker is spark plug wires. If they haven't been replaced for some time (or maybe never), the rubber insulation will develop cracks and allow the spark to jump to a metal part on the engine rather than going across the spark plug gap as it should. This causes the engine to misfire. In other words, your Studebaker will not run properly.

If there is any question as to how old the wires are, replace them. Also it's best to replace them especially if you've changed to a higher output ignition.

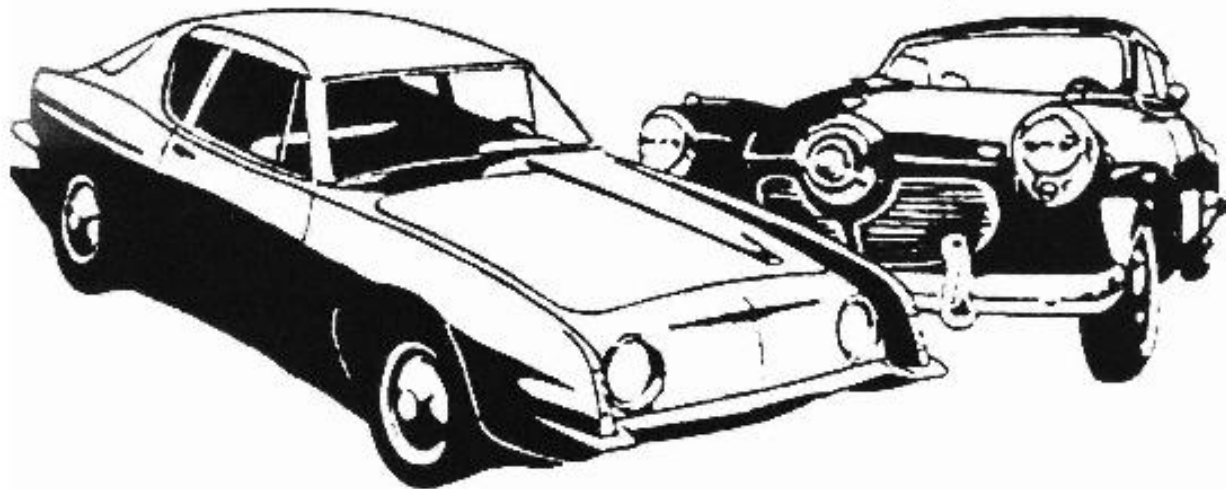
